

## Sticky Cinquefoil

*Potentilla glandulosa*  
Rose Family, *Rosaceae*



A common plant of many habitats with smallish cream colored to pale yellow petals that are mostly in clusters. This perennial has upper stems with glandular hairs that may feel somewhat sticky, hence the common name. The leaves are reminiscent of strawberry, strongly toothed, but with more leaflets.

An easy to grow plant for the garden with flowers lasting longer with part shade and moderate water.

## Silverweed

*Potentilla anserina* ssp. *pacifica*  
Rose Family, *Rosaceae*



Coastal brackish marshes, moist meadows, and stream banks along the Pacific Coast from Alaska to Southern California are home to this common, creeping, perennial herb. Its tufted, feather like leaves of 7-31 leaflets are silver below. Plants form large patches that are connected to each other by runners. A single yellow, five petaled flower with many stamens sits atop a leafless, sometimes slightly hairy stalk.

Silverweed was grown for food and medicine in the past. The cooked root is said to taste like sweet potato.
